



DIY Compatible TN-760 Cartridge Chip Installation Guide


This compatible cartridge does not include a chip to record the toner levels. In order to use the cartridge, you will need to move the small gold chip from your original (OEM) cartridge and place it onto your new cartridge. Your printer will show "empty" or "0" toner supply due to the used chip, but the cartridge will still be able to print for the full life cycle and print quality will not be affected.

Required Supplies:



- Previously used original toner cartridge.
- Small flathead screwdriver.


Using a small screwdriver, gently lift the old chip off the OEM toner cartridge.


Remove the white sticker from the chip slot on the new cartridge. This will expose a sticky surface where you will be placing the cartridge chip.

Transfer the old chip to the new compatible toner cartridge and press the chip down onto the sticky surface.

Try to avoid touching the chip with your fingers, as fingerprint residue may cause a faulty connection with your printer. If you do touch the chip with your fingers, clean the chip with a lint-free cloth.

Shake the cartridge back and forth a few times and install the toner cartridge into your printer!

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
